"Stalingrad Shoot" Military Shoot

Military Rifle Shoot

Saturday, February 6th, 2021 9:00 AM till 3:00 PM S1005 Knudson Lane, Coon Valley, WI

Rules – Vintage Rifle (100 yards)

- 1. Open to any centerfire rifle that was issued to any military organization, manufactured before 1960.
- 2. Rifle must have issue stock and issue iron sights.
- 3. Ammo should be of military power, either surplus, factory or reloads.
- 4. No shooting jacket or slings.
- 5. \$10.00 registration fee for each shooter. The course may be re-shot for an additional \$2.00 fee.

Rules - Modern Rifle(100 yards)

- 1. Open to any centerfire modern military style rifle (AR, AK, etc.)
- 2. Rifle may have any stock and any non-magnification sights.
- 3. Ammo should be of military power, either surplus, factory or reloads.
- 4. No shooting jacket or slings.
- 5. \$10.00 registration fee for each shooter. The course may be re-shot for an additional \$2.00 fee.

Rules – Modern Rifle Open Class (200 yards)

- 1. Open to any centerfire modern military style rifle (AR, AK, etc.)
- 2. Rifle may have any stock and any sights.
- 3. Ammo should be of military power, either surplus, factory or reloads.
- 4. No shooting jacket or slings.
- 5. The course of fire will be shot at 200 yards.
- 6. \$10.00 registration fee for each shooter. The course may be re-shot for an additional \$2.00 fee.

Course of fire


- 1. Total of 20 rounds will be fired. 5 rounds from each of 4 positions:
 - Standing
- Kneeling or sitting
- Prone
- "Bunker supported sandbags on the bench.
- The positions can be fired in any order, but all 5 rounds must be fired sequentially. Only 5 rounds are to be loaded at a time.
- 3. All 20 rounds will be fired at one target.
- 4. Shooter will have 15 minutes to fire all 20 rounds. Unfired rounds will be scored as 0.
- 5. Junior shooters will shoot at 50 yards with no time limit.

Target

- 1. A full size silhouette target will be used, similar to the FBI target, with scoring rings. Targets will be supplied by the CVCC.
- 2. Scores will be calculated by adding all hits in the scoring rings.

COST: Individual \$10.00, 2 person Team \$15.00 (Covers all events.)

PRIZES: For 1st & 2nd Place Individual in each of 6 Categories. 1^{st} & 2 Place Teams – 3 events total score.

Shoots are at bull's eye targets with unlimited number of targets/shoots. Turn in best target(s) – Pistol, Rimfire, Centerfire, and Muzzleloader each shoot 10 shots. Archery shoots 10 arrows – each at a separate bull's eye on a 5 bull's eye target. Shotgun shoots round of 25 clays (\$5.00 charge for each additional round to cover cost of clays).

- 5 SHOTS AT BULL'S EYE TARGET at Each Distance for a Total of 10 shots: (Any Sight) => Distances and Shooting Range:
- 1. PISTOL (Offhand) 12 yds & 25 yds Pistol Range
- 2. RIMFIRE(Offhand) 25 yds & 50 yds Rimfire/ML Range
- 3. MUZZLELOADER(Offhand) 25 yds & 50 yds Rimfire/ML Range
- 4. CENTERFIRE (Offhand) 100 yds & (Bench) 200 yds Big Bore Range
- 5. ARCHERY SHOOTS 10 ARROWS; 1 At Each BULL'S EYE on

Two 5 Bull's Eye Targets: (Archery Practice Area)

Arrow Launching Device & Distance:

*Compound - 30 yards BLOCK Target: *CrossBow - 30 yds. BAG Target:

*Traditional – 20 yds. BLOCK Target.
