CLUB PURCHASES NEW TRACTOR

We are proud to announce that the Club has recently purchased and took delivery of a new Kubota L Series 3830 4-wheel drive tractor. This tractor will replace the aging Ford Golden Jubilee tractor that has served the club so well in the past. The Board decided to purchase the new tractor for a number of reasons, including safety concerns and ongoing costs of maintaining the aging Ford tractor. The club looked at different models from local dealers and after an extensive research period, decided to purchase the Kubota model. The track record of Kubota combined with the quality and feel of the Kubota tractor contributed to the decision. We feel that this addition will serve our club well into the future. The tractor will be used for mowing operations, food plot management, and general use around the club grounds. With it's hydrostatic transmission and roll bar, we also feel that it will also provide a greater measure of safety to the volunteers that use the tractor at the club grounds. The tractor was purchased from Portland Implement in Cashton. The old Ford Golden Jubilee tractor is up for sale with the proceeds going to offset the costs of the new tractor. 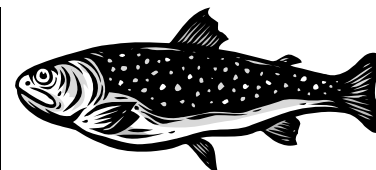
