## Shooter choice any 3 of the following

Archery 5 shots from 20 yards and 5 shots from 30 yards, total score 100 points

Rimfire 5 shots @ 25 yards and 5 shots @ 50 yards Total score 100 points

Center fire 5 Shots @ 100 yards and 5 shots @ 200 yards Total score 100 points

Trap 25 shots, each clay worth 4 points. Total score 100 points

Muzzleloader 5 shots @ 25 yards and 5 shots @ 50 yards Total score 100 points

Pistol 5 shots @ 12 yards and 5 shots @ 25 yards Total score 100 points

All shots from the standing position, any type of sight allowed

### New this year is a Muzzleloader Biathlon

Biathlon course is a little over ½ mile long with 4 stations of 3 shots each.

Open to any type of muzzleloader and any style of snowshoes
